- apply workplace organization techniques



When do I attend?

Training can be organised to suit the needs of employers and usually done on the job, as long as you are away from carrying out your usual duties to receive the training input needed. There may be a need to attend at Webs Training premises for some of the programme, but this will be agreed as required with the employer.

What qualifications will I get?

You will work towards a **Level 2 qualification in Business Improvement Techniques (BIP)** which is ideal if you work in a business improvement environment. You may already have some knowledge and basic skills in the industry.

You will need to complete the five core units for the pathway we offer in Process Improvement:

- Complying with statutory regulations and organisational safety requirements
- Contributing to effective team working.
- Applying workplace organisation techniques
- Applying continuous improvement techniques (Kaizen)
- Creating visual management systems.

Plus The employer will also choose one optional unit which best fits the business requirements from a choice of: Applying problem solving techniques, Carrying out potential failure modes and effects analysis (FMEA), and Creating standard operating procedures.

Plus improving Functional Skills in English and maths (where appropriate)

Progression Opportunities

Starting at level 2 you may want to progress to level 3 and lead on business improvement within your organisation. You may have the opportunity to move into different areas of the business to identify and eliminate waste, improve quality and create efficiencies. Opportunities may also exist to progress into roles such as business improvement co-ordinator, production team leader/supervisor, quality control manager, project team leader or production engineer.
