As a guide to completing these questions a word count guide has been added to each question. **Anything above the word count will be disregarded** from the judges' final decision.

The judges will be looking to grade your descriptions and examples using a marking scheme that has the following criteria-

9 - 10 points = Truly Exceptional

8 points = Impressive

6 - 7 Points = Good 4 - 5 Points = OK 1 - 3 = Weak
